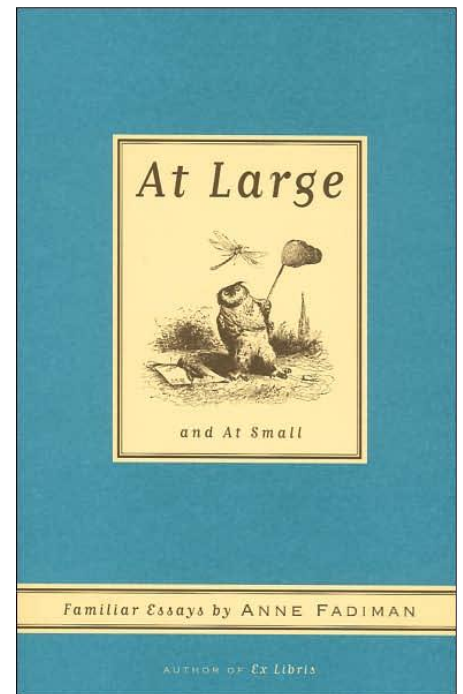
***James Prosek: Un-Natural History***
