In 2014, the deaths of numerous Black men, women, and children at the hands of police, including Tanisha Anderson, Dontre Hamilton, Eric Garner, John Crawford III, Michael Brown, Ezell Ford, Laquan McDonald, Akai Gurley, Gabriella Nevarez, Tamir Rice, Aura Rosser, Antonio Martin, and Jerame Reid, among others as well as justice for Ousmane Zongo's 2003 murder, and Aiyana Stanley-Jones' 2010 murder, led to #BlackLivesMatter demonstrations across the country.

Protests also focused attention on the 5th anniversary of the murder of Michael Brown, and the frustrating lack of progress in creating justice for Black Americans.

Protests also focused on the trial of Derek Chauvin for the murder of George Floyd.
