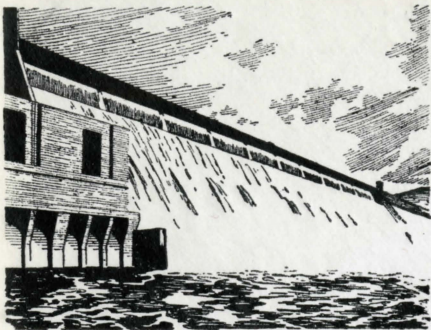

GRAND COULEE DAM

GRAND COULÉE DAM, ON THE COLUMBIA RIVER, WAS COMPLETED IN 1942 WHILE ITS PRIMARY PURPOSE IS TO PROVIDE WATER FOR IRRIGATION, THE ELECTRIC POWER GENERATED (1,964,000 KW) IS OF TREMENDOUS IMPORTANCE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST. THE RESERVOIR FORMED BY THE DAM IS 151 MILES LONG AND CAPABLE OF IRRIGATING 1,200,000 ACRES OF FERTILE LAND FORMERLY SUPPORTING ONLY SAGEBRUSH.
