

- EXTENSIVE USE OF LIBRARY SERVICES, RESOURCES AND COLLECTIONS, AND
- SIGNIFICANT KNOWLEDGE IN THE METHODS OF RESEARCH AND THE INFORMATION-GATHERING PROCESS

THERE ARE **4** REQUIREMENTS FOR A COMPLETE AWARD APPLICATION:

Requirements:

1. Be a Fairfield University undergraduate who has completed a research project for a credit course at Fairfield University during the Summer 2006, Fall 2006, or Spring 2007 semester.
2. Complete a 500-700 word essay describing your research strategies and use of library tools and resources.
3. Turn in a bibliography or other appropriate listing of sources consulted.
4. Get a letter of support from the supervising faculty member or instructor.


